REPEAT CHORUS

KEY CHANGE - **F**

VERSE 3:

F **Bb** **Eb** **G#**
First they had triplets and then they had quins
C# **F#** **C** **F**
A windmill with quins in, and triplets and twins in
F **A#** **Eb** **G#**
They sang every morning, "How lucky we are
C# **F#** **C** **F**
Living in a windmill in Amsterdam, ya!"
